Built in accessibility:

All mobile devices feature free built-in assistive technology. Most current devices provide free text to speech and speech to text (dictation technology).

There is ample information available about assistive tech available on Apple devices (see below).

For those with android devices a little investigation of the 'settings' of the device or a web search for info on AT tools on your particular device should reveal what is possible.

TOOLS THAT ASSIST WITH THE READING & RESEARCH PROCESS

Readerview

Enabling 'Readerview' in Safari declutters webpages by removing distracting images and pop-ups. You can also alter font size, text colour and background colour via 'readerview' on iPads and iPhones.

Text to Speech

You can have text anywhere on your iPad or iPad read aloud to you by your device by simply altering some settings, highlighting text then selecting, 'speak'



Prizmo Go

Download app: Prizmo Go - Text Grabber

Allows student to take photos of a text e.g. worksheets, a page in a book and have the text read aloud to them. This app also allows student to add typed or spoken notes to the document.

Seeing Ai

Download app: Seeing Ai

Scans Short Text - Speaks text as soon as it appears in front of the camera. Documents - Provides audio guidance to capture a printed page, and recognizes the text, along with its original formatting. Has many other applications.

Websites Tools that simplify complex texts

Rewordify

Website: Rewordify

Copy and paste text and rewording will simplify technical language. Has many other assistive features too.

Smmry

Website: <u>Smmry</u>

Copy and paste text or urls and **Smmry** will reduce the text to only the most important sentences.

Annotating (Website pages and PDFs)

You can 'mark-up' and save notes made to Webpages and PDFs on your iPad and iPhone.

Apps for mind mapping & planning

AudioNote

Download app: <u>AudioNote</u>

Students can take notes synced to audio voice recordings to plan a writing task or record ideas. Text, photos and videos can be added. Excellent for all subjects, ages and stages.

* Free version has pop-up ads.

Simple Mind

Download app: Simple Mind Mind-Mapping

Create a simple or detailed mind map to record your thoughts or key points from research.



Dictation Technology (Speech to Text) on Apple iPad/iPhone

On iPad and iPhone (and many android devices), you can dictate text instead of typing. For Apple devices make sure 'Enable Dictation' is turned on. On most mobile devices internet is required for dictation to work. Speaking close to the base of the iPad is best for that is where the microphone is located.

SnapType Download app: <u>SnapType</u>

Free version allows for 3 documents to be saved

Take photos of worksheets or import worksheets from anywhere on your device. Then use your keyboard or voice to add text to these documents. Allows user to print, email, or share their creations.

Photomath App

PhotoMath reads and solves handwritten mathematical expressions by using the camera of your mobile device in real time.

ModMath App

ModMath assists students who struggle with Mathematical notation. The app lets you write and solve math problems right onto the touch screen of an iPad using the custom keypad, and you can print, email, or save to cloud services like Dropbox.
