The **National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)** has started in the Queensland launch sites and is rolling out to other places in Queensland between July 2016 and July 2019.

The NDIS will give people with disability and the people close to them a chance to have a bigger say over their support.

This one day workshop talks about what we know about the NDIS, and some practical things people with disability and their families can do to get ready for the NDIS.

We will talk about what it takes for people with disability to have a good life; the role of family and friends; choice and control and what it will mean to take charge of the change ahead.

This workshop will help you think about where to start and how to stay connected and informed as we move towards the NDIS starting in an area near you.
