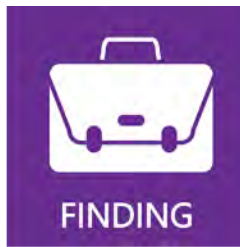

Finding Work - The Next Steps in Years 11 & 12

Monday 28th February, 2022 1:00pm - 2:30pm
(Brisbane, AEST)

This webinar is for secondary school students with disabilities and their families. Supporters and allies are also welcome to attend. This particular webinar has been designed for Years 11 & 12. Other webinars are being currently offered for Years 7 & 8 (Imagining work) and Years 9 & 10 (Discovering work).

This webinar, the second in the Finding Work series, will provide your secondary student and family with an opportunity to stop and consider what work is; why it's important and why it should not be dismissed as unachievable for people with disability.

Practical steps and tips will be offered including starting early and looking to your community and connections for opportunities to get started. Exploration of a variety of pathways through senior school years and to work are discussed including linking an NDIA support plan goal to employment.

This webinar also highlights the importance of reviewing each work experience; what your student liked/ disliked and why. The option of creating your own work role through customised employment will be discussed, as will developing a 'positive pitch' for an employer. Certificates, Apprenticeships and Internships are also examined.

The webinar will include live Q&A.
