# Imagining, Discovering and Finding Work

School to Work aims to inspire and equip students with disability through the support of their families to seek meaningful, paid employment in the community.

Join us for an interactive and participatory half-day online workshop that aims to bring a small number of families together to connect and increase confidence to seek out meaningful, paid employment for their secondary school student with disability.

This workshop will enable participants to get actively started in a range of processes so they leave with some concrete plans and strategies to find work for their family member.

Participants will hear stories and gain practical tips from experiences from people with a disability and family members.

- Exploring what good employment support looks like and how to find the right people to support your family member
