WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) course covers the knowledge and skills required to provide CPR:

- ◆ Infection control procedures and first aid codes of practice.
- ◆ CPR and defibrillation for adults and infants
- ◆ Recognise, manage and assess an emergency situation.
- ◆ Use an automatic external defibrillator (AED).
- ◆ Understand DRSABCD and the first aider's legal responsibilities.
- ◆ Duty of care and own skills and limitations.
- ◆ Ensure safety for self, bystanders and the casualty.
- ◆ Assess the casualty and recognise the need for CPR.
- ◆ Seek assistance from emergency services.
- ◆ Perform CPR in accordance with the ARC guidelines.
- ◆ Display respectful behaviour towards the casualty.
- ◆ Provide an accurate verbal report of the incident and review the incident.

The CTO accredited CPR training program offers convenient online learning of the fundamentals of CPR, followed by practical hands-on workshops.

Session 1 – Online Learning and Assessment

(Approx. up to 2 hours to complete)

The online learning component allows you the flexibility, time, and space to learn and complete important theory assessments at your own pace, when and wherever you want! The actual duration of this component will vary depending on your experience and knowledge.

You will need access to a computer, and the internet to complete this part of the course. Mobile phones are not recommended due to the small screen size.

You must have successfully completed the online assessment prior to attending the practical face-to-face component of the course.

Session 2 – Face-to-Face Practical Session

(Approx. 2 hours)

Our face-to-face practical session gives you the opportunity to apply the knowledge you have learned and develop the hands-on skills, practice them, receive trainer feedback, and then complete assessment tasks based on first aid or emergency scenarios.

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HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation is required to be refreshed every 12 months from the date of certificate to remain current.



Duration and Delivery

This is a blended course with self-paced online learning and face-to-face training. Before attending the face-to-face training, students will need to complete their online learning which can be done in one sitting or over several sessions.

Students should allow up to 2 hours for reading and online learning. Face-to-face training and assessment will take approx. 2 hours in the classroom.

Entry Requirements

There are no specific entry requirements for this unit of competency.

Students are required to commence Session 1 Online Theory prior to attending Session 2. Students will have their practical session rescheduled if online learning has not been completed.
