Every young person deserves to get a job they love. Societal attitudes and low expectations around disability present an unfair barrier to young people. This webinar will feature Jane Sherwin, one of only two senior trainers in Social Role Valorisation (SRV) in Australia. If you are a parent or supporter of a young person with disability who wants to see the young person find real work that they enjoy, then this session is for you. The webinar will include live Q&A.

Participants will learn approaches that are informed by Social Role Valorisation (SRV), a framework that many families have used to create good lives for their loved ones with disability.

We will explore how we can support young people with disability to find and keep employment suited to their interests and where they make a valuable contribution, and not limited by others' ideas on what is possible.
