Developing a Visual Resume for Work

This event is a part of our School To Work Project which aims to inspire and equip students with disability, through the support of families, to seek meaningful, paid employment in the community.

In this webinar, we will discuss alternative ways to share with potential employers what a young person can offer in experience, skills and strengths.

This webinar will focus on visual resumes, an alternative to a traditional resume, and show what it is and how others have used it to help find meaningful paid employment in their community.

- Examples of visual resumes
- Creating speaking notes to accompany the visual resume
- How to get started crafting a visual resume of your own.
