She has worked with national and state agencies to develop and improve strategy and policy, to increase access to services that result in competitive, inclusive employment for individuals with disabilities. Therese joined Marc Gold & Associates (MG&A) in 2019 and became president of the organisation in 2022.

Randy's work in the human service field is vast—ranging from working with the homeless, victims of sexual abuse, those with criminal histories, and those who experience mental health, physical, and intellectual disabilities. Although varied in experience, his work has always focused on each individual, their goals and needs, and tailoring services to what will work best for them. He strives to implement this philosophy every day. Randy has found that Customised Employment truly is a way to help people with significant barriers to employment find meaning and purpose through a job in the community, making real wages and living the life they envision for themselves. Randy joined MG&A as a consultant in 2013. He is a lead instructor for MG&A as well as the director of MG&A's Performance-Based Certification program.
